

## **Aliens Act, Article 65**

- 1 A foreign national:
  - a. who has entered the Netherlands on board a vessel or aircraft operated by a carrier and who is required to leave the Netherlands immediately, or
  - b. who has been detained with a view to his removal within six months of his arrival on board a vessel or aircraft operated by a carrier, may be removed by being put on board a vessel or aircraft operated by the same carrier.
- 2 The carrier transports, at the instruction of a border control officer, without charge, the foreign national referred to in paragraph 1, back to a place outside the Netherlands and finds, if necessary, a different means of transportation in order to carry him back. If this is not possible within a reasonable period or, in the case referred to in paragraph 1(b), is not possible within a reasonable period after the detention, the costs of removal from the Netherlands may be recovered from that carrier.
- 3 Captains of vessels and aircraft shall give their full cooperation in the removal of the foreign national as may reasonably be required of them by the border control officer.
- 4 Paragraph 1(b) shall not apply to a foreign national who is lawfully resident until a date later than the departure of the vessel or aircraft on board of which he arrived in the Netherlands.
